

FAQ Sheet for New Location for the Crossroads Campus

We celebrate God's provision of the building on 450 South Main Street in Greensburg! We are most excited about the opportunity for God to build His church in downtown Greensburg. In the months ahead, we will face many hurdles, difficult decisions, and the reality of having to say "yes" to some things and "no" to others.

We want to be united in what we are communicating to our church family. We have already received many questions around the future of our new location. We want to guard against misunderstanding, therefore we are creating an FAQ sheet that will be a working document that we will regularly update as we receive questions. We will answer with clarity and as much detail as we have at the time. We will always receive people's feedback and questions with love, and seek to explain the "why" behind decisions that have been made.

Above all, we want to keep the main thing, the main thing.

The main thing for us is seeking to fulfill God's vision for Charter Oak Church as lived out by our mission to reach out to those who are searching and equip believers to be fully devoted followers of Jesus. We recognize that Satan will use every opportunity to get a foothold in our church and destroy our unity. We want to foster an openness to listening well, loving and respecting one another.

Questions...

- ***What will the campus be named?***

A decision hasn't been made about the future name of the campus. Church Council has discussed naming campuses according to the city/region where they are. Our campuses that were started after the Crossroads Campus have followed that design – Charter Oak Church Jeannette Campus and Charter Oak Church Mount Pleasant/Scottdale Campus.

The primary reason for this name design is to make it easier for people who are searching for a church home to be able to find one of our campuses based on the name of the campus instead of a specific landmark that wouldn't make sense to a new person.

- ***Will we have outside worship at our new location?***

Outdoor worship was started at all of our campuses as creative way for our church to begin to gather for in-person worship sooner during COVID. The Crossroads Campus has continued to use outdoor worship three times a year to create more space for more people to hear the Gospel.

The main reason we are moving to a new location is to provide more space for more people to hear the Good News of Jesus, not just three times a year, but every Sunday. At this point we don't know the City of Greensburg's sound ordinance and we want to make sure that we are good neighbors to the families that live very close to our new location. Ultimately, we will do our due diligence and prayerfully consider outdoor worship in the future.

- ***What will the new space look like?***

The Building Team is working with an architect and construction company in the design of our new space – inside and outside. We want to create a space that will best serve our ability to fulfill the mission of our church and to do so in a cost effective way that we can afford. As soon as the design is complete we will share those drawings with our church family.

- ***When will we move to the new location?***

As we are still in the design phase, anticipating a date is challenging. We will share details here as progress is made.

- ***How can I help during the renovation of the new space?***

As soon as we have the final cost estimate from our construction company, Church Council will request a Church Conference that will give members of our church the opportunity to vote. We are required to communicate the date of that church vote at least two weeks in advance. We are committed to getting that information to our church members as soon as we have it.
