

Community Outreach Intern – Jeannette campus

The Jeannette campus's ministry plan to fulfill Charter Oak Church's mission includes being present in the city of Jeannette. This involves engaging our community through attending and participating in community events and partnering with like-minded local non-profits, churches, and organizations in Jeannette. We are seeking an intern to assist with this work who is interested in gaining experience in urban ministry, community organizing, poverty alleviation, or similar work.

Project: Identify community resources and events in Jeannette and lead our congregation to participate in at least one community outreach event in Jeannette.

- Meet with existing partners and identify local mission opportunities
- Establish relationships with various community leaders and partners.
- Research and identify existing community events and opportunities.
- Select one community engagement opportunity being organized in the community that will align with our church mission.
- Lead a team from our church in participating in the event. This will include recruiting congregants, leading team meetings, and building relationships with both the church and the community.

Other work would include:

- Regular one on ones with the campus pastor
- Attending worship to meet and recruit the congregation.
- Attend Local Mission Team meetings
- Research and identify community resources available in Jeannette
- Form a community resource packet
- Communicate opportunities to the congregation and Central Services.
- Study and understand the Jeannette campus ministry plan
- Study and articulate how being present in our community is an expression of being a Deployed Missionary.
