

Sending is a vital contribution to the Great Commission. Going cannot happen without sending. Here are some ways to be a sender!

SEND our short-term missionaries:

- Pray for an individual goer. Pray for a team.
- Give financially. Talk to the missions manager about specific needs.
- Provide lunch or dinner (or a portion of it) for a team pre-trip meeting.
- Read goer stories on the missions blog: www.charteroak.church/sentmissionsblog.
- Purchase supplies. Ask the missions manager about specific needs. For example:
Pay for the medicines the Panama team will take to their medical clinics.
Pay for the Spanish Bibles that the Panama team will share.
Rent the van for the New York City team.
Purchase building materials or nonperishable food for the Big Creek team.
Donate snacks for a team.
Buy what's on the Jamaica team shopping list.
- Meet with a goer after their trip to hear about their experience.
- Drive goers to the airport or pick them up.

SEND our long-term workers:

- Pray.

- Sign up for a worker's newsletter. Read it and reply to it.
- Give financially.
- Ask the missions manager about joining a worker's prayer team or home team.
- Ask the missions manager about sending a letter or care package.
- Join an online conversation with a worker.
- Give your time and share a skill. What are you good at? A few ideas:
Help with taxes.
Take photographs when they are on home assignment.
Host an online meeting .
Give feedback on a newsletter.
Design a prayer card.
- Offer the use of a car or housing or a weekend getaway to a worker on home assignment.
